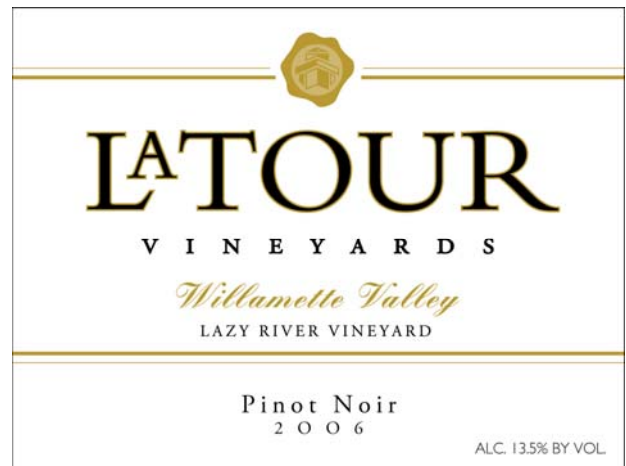

2006 Tasting Notes

With a depth of color alluding to the richness of the wine, this velvety Pinot Noir entices with aromas of pancetta and dark cherry and follow through with ripe plum notes and spicy, lingering finish.



Appellation:	Willamette Valley, Oregon. Lazy River Vineyards is just three miles from Yamhill. Starting at an elevation of 250 feet, the vineyard quickly slopes upward until reaching 425 feet. The land is predominantly made up of Jory soil, believed by many to produce a superior Pinot Noir grape.
Vineyards:	Lazy River Vineyard, vines planted in 2001
Release Date:	May 2008
Production:	98 cases
Fermentation/ Aging	Open top vats with manual punch-down, 12 months in French Oak barrels, using natural yeasts.
